Ninety Years of Accomplishments: For more than 90 years, MOAA has engaged with Congress on all manner of issues related to the uniformed services community. These efforts have often been accomplished on a singular basis or through collaboration with like-minded organizations and with The Military Coalition. MOAA during those years has also relied heavily upon its members making their voices known to their legislators via MOAA's Legislative Action Center and through participation in the annual Advocacy In Action program. MOAA has worked to ensure military pay and benefits have been protected from budget-driven threats, continued access to quality medical care, and countless other areas of concern to its members, our military, and the wider uniformed services community. There is no way to list every achievement since 1929, but MOAA has categorized and highlighted their accomplishments into six categories which are listed below.
